Designed specifically for Webelos den leaders and their assistants, the Outdoor Skills for Webelos Leaders course teaches outdoor-related skills through demonstration and hands-on practice. Webelos den leaders should attend this training before conducting Webelos overnight camping with the boys and parents of the den. In addition to covering basic camping skills, this training features detailed planning of campouts, finding of resources, and tips on at least five different Webelos Activity Badges related to the outdoors.
