## TRAINING REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL UNITS

Effective June 1, 2010, all registered adults must complete Youth Protection Training every two years. The Top Leader of each unit must be Trained for their position or the unit will not be allowed to recharter for 2012. Top Leader, as defined by the national office, is Cubmaster, Scoutmaster, Varsity Team Coach, Venturing Crew Advisor, and Skipper.
